The above is being filed in accordance with Certificate Condition 20 of the Order Granting a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need, with Conditions, issued on January 17, 2018.

Please note, the Decommissioning Agreements reflect an update of the Facility from the original decommissioning estimate which was based on the Siting Board's approval of 48 unspecified turbines. The Applicant has identified the turbines to be used for the Facility and reduced the number of turbines to 37. Given the more than 20% reduction in turbines, the Town of Cherry Creek, with advice from its consultant GHD, approved a reduction in the decommissioning estimate to reflect the actual number of turbines proposed for the Facility. The Town of Charlotte's Decommissioning Estimate remains proportional to the amount identified in the Certificate Order for the 48-turbine arrangement. Also, for clarification, the decommissioning estimates in the approved plans include the potential decommissioning of the proposed 115 kV transmission feeder line.
